

Lummi Nation School (SY 13-14) Medical Information:

Immunizations:

Hand washing is a simple thing and it's the best way to prevent infection and illness. Clean hands prevent infections. Keeping hand clean prevents illness at home, at school and at work.

To prevent the spread of disease, all students should be in compliance with scheduled immunizations.

Students entering school for the first time must provide documentation of immunizations.

Students who do not have appropriate immunizations will be removed from school until immunization information is provided.

Head Lice:

Students are frequently checked for head lice. If found, families will be notified, and a letter will be sent home regarding the care and treatment of head lice.

Medications at School:

When possible, please give required medication at home. If it is not possible, the school nurse or trained staff member will administer the medication.

Medication at school must be accompanied by a parental consent and physician's order at the beginning of each year.

Medicine must be brought to the school by a parent or guardian.
